LSC's newest FAA approved life vest, The TRITON PAX uses the same flotation bladder worn by U.S. Coast Guard Helicopter Rescue Swimmers. It is doubtful that any inflatable bladder design has seen as much in-water action as the LSC TRITON. This life vest is professional-grade and made for years of rugged wear and substantial abuse.

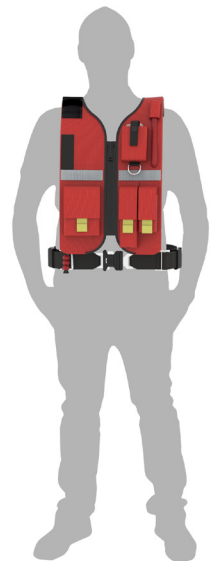
The TRITON flotation vest provides variable buoyancy up to 35lbs using a manually inflated CO₂ cylinder. The folding pattern and snap closure create a comfortable low-profile fitting around the neck. Three utility pockets on the front of the vest allow for storage of auxiliary equipment (also available in MOLLE as the #497-PAX-M). The vest comes equipped with an LSC survivor locator light that is visible up to 3.5 miles depending on atmospheric conditions. An oral inflation valve allows the wearer to adjust buoyancy, as needed.

The attachment harness is constructed of Mil-Spec webbing and low profile, quick adjusting, stainless steel hardware. All components and materials are corrosion resistant for the marine environment.
